

This exclusive interview delves into her emotive journey, artistic inspirations, and the groundbreaking plans set to reshape the sonic landscape of the continent.



Kiki realized she had no one to blame but herself for her decisions. Wunmi or Tayo didn't force her to do anything; she had made those choices and was now living with the consequences.


The only positive outcome from her 11-year marriage with Tayo was their 10-year-old daughter Teniola, who is her entire world and the main reason why she was still with Tayo.


ESCAPE MAG: Beyond the Screen: While KhloesGram shines on TikTok, what other passions and projects are lighting up your world?

#### **About the Collection**



ESCAPE MAG: "III-Fated" and "Deeply in Love" are among your recent projects. What draws you to the roles you choose, and how do you approach your character preparation?


NANZO: Most times I don't choose a role because of the role... I choose scripts based on the whole story. I love stories that start conversations.

Bolt Food Ceases Operations in Nigeria, Cites Resource Optimization



As of December 7, 2023, Bolt Food will discontinue its food delivery service in Nigeria, marking a strategic decision to optimize resources and enhance overall efficiency. Launched in October 2021 to meet pandemic-driven demand, Bolt Food collaborated with over 10,000 restaurants, delivered one million meals, and engaged 23,000 agents and 12,000 merchants.

Facing competition from Jumia Food, Gokada, Glovo, Chowdeck, and Buyfood, Bolt Food exits the \$834.7 million Nigerian food delivery market. While Bolt cites resource optimization, rival ChowDeck reports surpassing #1 billion (\$1.2 million) in monthly orders, emphasizing organic growth.

Challenges persist in Nigeria's food delivery sector, including escalating fuel prices, leading to increased delivery fees. A rising inflation rate adds to operational costs, and inadequate road networks contribute to delayed deliveries. Competition intensifies with new entrants, coupled with issues like inaccurate map locations and traffic congestion, compounding challenges for food delivery services in the region.
